Sub: Establishment of National Project Monitoring Unit at National Productivity Council, HQ in collaboration with Indian CST, Bangalore


We are pleased to inform you that competent authority has given the approval for establishing of National Project Monitoring Unit at National Productivity Council, Lodi Road, New Delhi in collaboration with Indian CST, Bangalore as a part of activities of development of e-pashuhaat GPMS Transportal which was launched on 26th November 2016 by the Hon'ble Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Govt. of India for further maintenance and smooth functioning of this GPMS Transportal. Besides this Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries desires NPC to develop following portals on the similar pattern of e-pashuhaat.

- 1 E-Poultry Haat
- 2 E-Goat Haat
- 3 E-Sheep Haat
- 4 E-Fisheries Haat (*Mera Matasya Dhan*)

Further, Agribusiness Group has 5 major assignments namely Evaluation of RKVY (40 schemes), Preparation of C-DAP (40 districts), Evaluation of Agro Technologies of CSIR-IHBT, Evaluation of various schemes of Department of Consumer Affairs and Study for examining the reasons for high dropout rates among all minorities communities which involves extensive survey work. The service of the PMU would be utilized in these assignments also. Apart from Agribusiness group, the other divisions of NPC may also utilize the services of experts to be made available in the PMU for any short duration project / survey works which require greater IT enabled technology applications.

As you are aware that NPC has an MoU with Indian CST for utilizing technical expertise of the organization. The National Project Monitoring Unit will be involved in the above-mentioned projects for their survey work, monitoring and evaluation as per requirements. The cost for doing such work will be decided mutually based on the projects undertaken.
